Statement of Chairman of Islamic Unity Party, Afghanistan, regarding martyrdom of innocent Hazaras by Terrorists on May 6, 2011 in Quetta, Pakistan.

Once again the Hazara community in Quetta has become the victims of a tragic terror attack by the well known terrorists resulting in the murder of 5 [1] innocent Muslims and injuring of 9 [2] others. This sad news brings immense sorrow and pain to thousands of you as well as me. It is not the first time the Hazara people living in Quetta have been the victim of terrorism. Indeed they have been targeted by these terrorists time and again, in which hundreds of innocent people have lost their lives, and it shows how weak the Pakistani Government is in fighting these terrorists. The home grown terrorists [in Pakistan] together with the international terrorists have created a safe heaven within Pakistan and have succeeded in terrorizing the whole region.

Bin Laden, the leader of terrorists around the world, has been arrested from the same territory and faced his crimes accordingly. But other terrorists, occupying the semi-autonomous tribal areas close to Afghanistan boarder, are launching barbaric terror attacks not only in Pakistan but in the whole world. I share your pain due to this tragic in-human and Un-Islamic terror attack. I ask you to remain calm and patient, and to stand united with each other, so that these morally bankrupt enemies of humanity know that by killing some of us, they will not kill us all, nor will they succeed in stopping our progress in fields of education, culture, commerce, and politics.
